



XIII Lunas 2014

Every year, the Moon circles the Earth thirteen times, thus completing 13 lunations.

XIII Lunas 2012 is a modern wine of Garnacha and Tempranillo, made in Rioja Alta and aged for thirteen lunar cycles.

DOCa: Rioja

Varietals: Garnacha (55%), Tempranillo (45%).

Ageing: 12 months in 225 l. barrels of American and French wood.

Alcohol: 13.5% vol.

pH: 3.47

Total acidity: 5.13 g/l (a.t.).

Volatile acidity: 0.47 g/l (a.a.).

Sugar: 0.6 g/l.

Free SO₂: 27 mg/l.

Total SO₂: 76 mg/l.

Tasting note: Cherry red colour, with a violet trim. Bright and clean. Fresh aromas of redberries, with very well melted balsamic and oak notes. In the mouth it is fresh, meaty and full. It's round and clean tannins give it a lot of elegance. A fresh, modern, nice Rioja wine.
